LAGOON REPAIR REPORT

The administrator gave a verbal report with regard to the ongoing Lagoon repairs and construction. The discharge line and valve for cell 3 has been installed and is complete. We are having trouble exposing the drain ends between cell 2 and cell 3 so that we can excavate and replace the valve between the two cells. It is planned that we will dig beside the valve and expose the top of the valve to see if we can manually operate the valve. If so, we will replace the box and rod and be done. If not, we will rent a 6" trash pump from Flaman's to pump the two cells below the drain levels.

remove the remaining water from cells 2 and 3 so that the valve can be changed between cells 2 and 3.
